## PLAYER FEES



Despite the fact that this season there will only be 4 players bowling at one time, we were still able to keep the same pricing of $\$ 20 /$ week. Please note the following:

- The total cost for the season will be $\$ 240 /$ player (12 week season).
- Teams with more than 4 bowlers - only 4 will be included in the payment booklets. Regular bowlers or substitutes (beyond 4) can put their money towards the balance of another player that is not participating. Total for the team will be $\$ 80$ per night regardless of how many bowlers are participating.
- We are unable to offer a discount this year for those players that choose to pay in full the first night.
- This year, bowlers are only permitted to be behind in payments ONE WEEK. A late fee will be accessed for any bowler that falls behind more than one week.
- The fee will increase to $\$ 25 /$ week for any player that is behind more than one week until they are caught up.
- Scores for any bowler that participates while being more than two weeks behind will not count and an absentee score will be used instead.
- Bowlers must be current in payments in order to participate in the last two weeks of the season.
- It is highly recommended for all bowlers to stay a little bit ahead in order to avoid late fees due to an unexpected absence.
- Teams that Pre-Bowl do not pay the bowling alley that night. It is recommended instead to send Ryan payments through Venmo or Paypal as to not fall behind and potentially begin to incur late fees.
- Bowlers are responsible for the entirety of the season's league fees once they participate in Week 1. In the event that someone has to quit for any reason, a substitute must begin to take over the payments for that player, or the team will become responsible to make up the difference.
- In the event we lose multiple weeks due to weather or a change in COVID regulations, we will refund all players that have overpaid at that point, whether they are a week or two ahead, or have paid in full for the season.
